

Memorandum of Understanding  
Between the Hermosa Beach City School District and the Hermosa Beach Educators  
Association

The Hermosa Beach City School District and the Hermosa Beach Educators Association enter into this Memorandum of Understanding concerning unit member Interdistrict Permits as follows:

Full time bargaining unit members who live outside the District must annually request and be granted an Interdistrict Permit for their children to attend District schools from their district of residency. As a professional courtesy, Hermosa District shall grant such a bargaining unit member's request unless it is revoked for any of the following reasons as determined by the District:

- a. Excessive truancy, continual disruption of the educational program or defiance of school authority.
- b. Appropriate and sufficient space is unavailable in the existing class, school or district. A student shall not be granted an Interdistrict permit which results in the denial of an Interdistrict permit to a continuing permit student. District Special Education class size limits are 15 for Resource Specialist and 5 for Special Day Class and Preschool which leaves room for growth if district residents enter the programs during the school year through the special education identification processes.
- c. The additional cost of educating the individual Interdistrict Permit student would exceed the amount of additional state aid that would be received as a result of the placement of the individual Interdistrict Permit student. If the Interdistrict Permit student's district of residence agrees to pay excess costs for the student's special needs, the student may remain providing there is space in the program.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall terminate on June 30, 2007 unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties.
